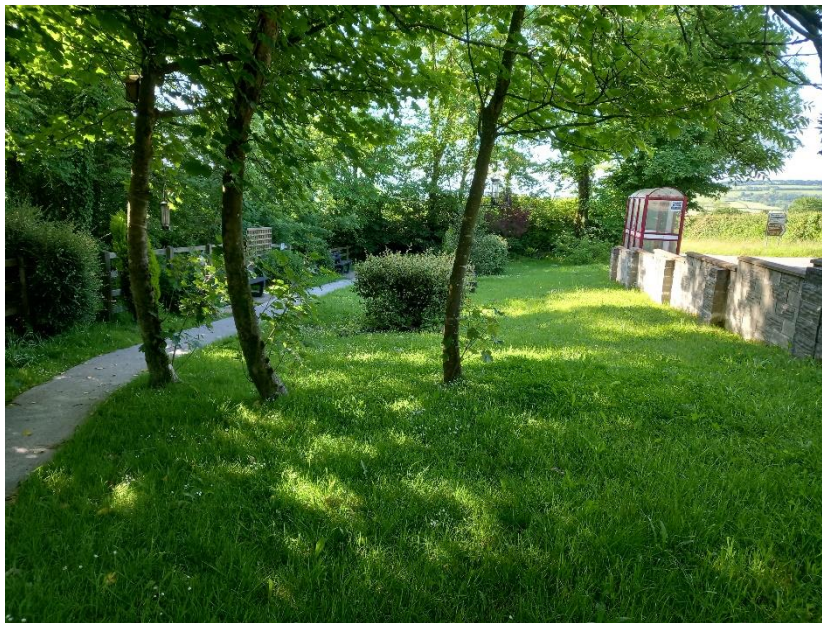

6. Gweithgareddau yn ystod 2024-25

Roedd 2024-25 yn flwyddyn brysur arall i'r Cyngor Cymuned. Mae'r Cyngor yn gweithredu'n rhagweithiol i gynrychioli trigolion lleol ac yn adrodd am faterion sy'n peri pryder i'r Cyngor Sir. Mae hyn yn cynnwys pryderon diogelwch ar y ffyrdd, tipio anghyfreithlon, atgyweirio ffyrdd a goleuadau troedffyrdd a materion cynllunio. Mae'r Cyngor wedi cyfarfod â sefydliadau perthnasol a Cyngorau arall er mwyn adlewyrchu Pryderon Cymunedol mewn perthynas â'r Prosiect Peilon Gen Gwyrdd a datblygiad arfaethedig yr is-orsaf.

Ym mis Tachwedd trefnodd y Cyngor Wasanaeth Sul y Cofio yn yr Eglwys a Thir Gof yn Llandyfaelog ar y cyd â Changen Cydweli a'r Lleng Prydeinig Brenhinol ac awdurdodau Eglwys Llandyfaelog.

6. Activity during 2024-25

2024-25 was another busy year for the Community Council. The Council acts pro-actively to represent local residents and reports issues of concern to the County Council. This includes road safety concerns, flytipping, footway lighting repairs, pot holes and planning issues. The Council has met with relevant organisations and other Councils in order to reflect Community Concerns in relation to the Green Gen Pylon Project and proposed substation development.

In November the Council arranged a Remembrance Sunday Service at the Church and Tir Gof in Llandyfaelog in conjunction with Kidwelly Branch and the Royal British Legion and the Llandyfaelog Church authorities.

Plannu Bylbiau Daffodiliau / Daffodil Bulb Planting

A number of daffodil bulbs were planted across the Community by Llandyfaelog Community Council and volunteers, including the children of Cywion Bach in Idole, following receipt of bulbs through County Councillor Tyssul Evans and the Carmarthenshire County Council Administered, UK Government SPF Fund. Planting took place in Cwmffrwd, Croesyceiliog, Glanmorlais, Idole and Llandyfaelog.
